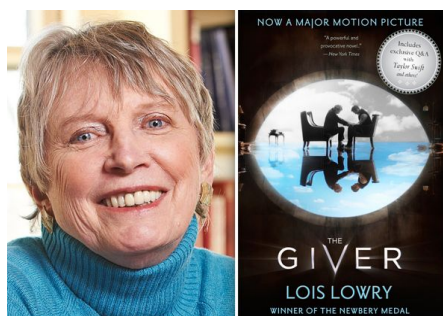

World Book Day - Thursday 4th March 2021

On Thursday 4th March, we will be celebrating World Book Day. To celebrate reading and the love of books we will be hosting a variety of events across the day as outlined below.

Adding a 2021 twist to a previous event, we will be having a **'masked get caught reading' competition**. Students are invited to submit photos of themselves (or their pets!) reading in unusual places whilst wearing a mask to add to our display. Photos can be submitted by responding to the Google Classroom assignment in their year group classes.

Other students who wish to will be able to participate - details regarding rooming will be shared with students closer to the time.

Finally, there will be a mask decoration competition where students will be invited to decorate a medical mask around the theme of their favourite book or author. Masks will be provided to students in school.
