Feedback from Parent Survey

Time spent with children: 1-2 hours all KS

Support required at start of the day: 55% to 0%

Review of learning: Always 11-30%

Quality of feedback: Fairly/very for 93-100% except EY - 72%

Balance right: 78% (P and R in Primary - 89%)

Screen time (school): KS3 and KS4 at 57% and 70% for 7+ hours

Screen time (non school): 45-68% for 1-2 hours

Clarity on instructions: 92-97%

Info on provision/rationale: c70%

Locating school support: 82%

Internet hotspot: 30% still facing issues even with HS and 34% without



Overall satisfaction: 72-97%

Primary

Keeping learning flexible and simple

All learning shared at the start of the day through Seesaw/Tapestry and using programs students are already familiar with, e.g. Google Slides, Reading Eggs

We provide an overview of the next week to parents every Friday to allow them to plan their time

Task options: **Responsibilities** and **Possibilities**



Bespoke 1:1, small group and whole class Zoom sessions throughout the week

Validate learning

We keep feedback positive and verbal where possible

We use the audio comments option on Seesaw/Tapestry

Online summative assessments utilised

Celebrate 'learning of the week' via a class Seesaw/Tapestry blog



Class and themed assemblies continue to celebrate and showcase learning

Focus on wellbeing daily

Each day starts with a video message / live Zoom

1 wellbeing activity each day

We provide opportunities for learners to communicate with their class (e.g. Seesaw / Tapestry blog; live Zooms)



Provide regular feedback & communication

'Office hours' for staff communication with parents and students are 8:30-4:30

Replies to parental emails should take place within 24 hours of receiving them

Provide responses to all Seesaw & Tapestry posts within 24 hours
