## PLEASE FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES IN FILLING YOUR CHRISTMAS GIFT BAGS:

### 1. COLLECT YOUR CHRISTMAS GIFT BAGS

Primary bags will be distributed by their teachers. Students will then bring the bags home with them to be filled. These should be returned to school no later than **Friday, 3rd December**.

### 2. PURCHASE GIFT ITEMS

Items that can be included in the bag must be new and below are some of the suggestions:

- **NEW SMALL TOYS:**

Games (no cards), puzzles, soft toys, balls and jump ropes.

- **SCHOOL SUPPLIES:**

Pencils, pens, erasers, sharpeners, colored pencils, markers, colouring books, notepads and crayons.

- **TOILETRIES:**

Toothbrush, toothpaste, hair comb and a bar of soap.

- **ACCESSORIES:**

Socks, hat, scarf and gloves.

**Please do not put food or used items in the bags.**

**Red bags are for 4-6 years old children. Green bags are for 7-9 years old children.**

### 3. FILL THE CHRISTMAS GIFT BAG

Fill the bags with the gifts that you purchased. If you choose to make a card you are welcome to do so.

### 4. DROP OFF

Primary Students, hand the bags over to your teachers.
