Unfortunately, due to continued staff shortages and challenges related to the COVID situation, lessons for all year groups will be online next week. Teachers are able to continue to provide high quality online lessons for students but may not be able to teach from the school site due to travel and COVID disruption.

We remain committed to following the government guidance in relation to schools and working within this. We hope that the situation will stabilise soon and therefore look forward to having students on campus, under the government access arrangements, as soon as it is practical.

We are working with the relevant authorities to schedule the second vaccination dose for our students who are over 12. If any student is still waiting for their first dose, we hope to be able to support with this.
