## Temporary online learning provision

We hope you had a wonderful Christmas holiday and we have very much enjoyed welcoming the students back for Term 3. Unfortunately, further to the letter from Ms Drumm, we will temporarily be learning online for the next few weeks.

Your child's full timetable will be shared with you by their class teacher on Seesaw tomorrow morning, and will consist of 6 learning episodes throughout the day. These will be a combination of live Zoom lessons and Seesaw based directed tasks. The live Zoom lessons will consist of direct teaching and then the teacher will set a task to be completed independently. It is important that your child takes a break from screen between lessons and has a structured break at both break and lunch times where they are not completing work.
