Dear Parents and Carers,

Student COVID-19 Vaccinations

We have received notification that we will be a vaccination centre tomorrow, Wednesday January 12th. All students who registered with us in December will be able to receive their 1st vaccine on site, we believe this will be Pfizer.

If you did not register with us in December, but would like your child to receive a vaccine, please contact the school nurses asap by emailing nurse@tbs.edu.np. We will try to arrange for your names to be added to the list, however this will be the decision of the vaccine administrators, not the school. By registering with the school for this, parents are providing consent for their child's COVID-19 vaccination to take place.

Please note that students must be over 12 years of age to be eligible to receive the vaccine. Students in Y7 who are still under 12 will be able to also come into school tomorrow so that they can familiarise themselves with the process for when they become eligible in a few months.

Y7-Y13 students should be in school tomorrow at the usual time and will wait in classes until it is their turn to receive the vaccination. They will be monitored in classrooms and can return home as usual at 3:25pm. Scheduled exams will take place as normal. All students should continue to follow the school's health and safety procedures while on campus.

IMPORTANT: Students have been asked to bring a piece of official ID which includes their name and D.O.B e.g. passport.
