## COVID-19 Vaccinations: Friday February 4th

I am pleased to inform you that we will be facilitating further vaccinations on Friday, February 4th for students aged 12-17 years. Students who have already received their first dose will be able to receive the second dose. Additional eligible students who have not received any vaccinations yet, will be able to receive their first dose by registering [here](#) today. By registering with the school, parents are providing consent for their child's COVID-19 vaccination to occur. Students must be over 12 years of age.

Year 7	10:30	11:10	<b>Year 10 Music &amp; Year 11 Drama students</b> We have made additional arrangements for our <b>Year 10 Music</b> and <b>Year 11 Drama</b> students so that progress can be made in their coursework. These students will need to <b>arrive at TBS at 10.45am</b> where they will be met by a supervising teacher. During lessons 3 and 4, the students will remain supervised and continue with their learning as per their normal timetable (in addition to receiving their vaccination). Following this, students will need <b>to be collected at 12.40pm</b> so that they may return home in time for Lesson 5. Our Head of Performing Arts (Ms. Robyn Wynn) will share further details regarding this opportunity and the activity logistics.

Students will be registered, vaccinated and then, once they have been monitored by the medical team, can then return home. We expect this process to take 30-40 minutes. All students should continue to follow the school's health and safety procedures while on campus.

### IMPORTANT:

- Students receiving their first dose must bring a piece of official ID which includes their name and D.O.B e.g. passport.
- Students receiving a second dose must bring their vaccination card.
- Please note that if students have had COVID in the last few months they may not be able to receive their vaccination at this time. There is a recommended delay and we are currently seeking clarification from the vaccination team about the local guidance on this.
