Dear Parents and Carers,

Campus Access from February 14th 2022

We have been monitoring the situation and our capacity to have students on site in line with the new government guidance. We are pleased to let you know that we will be inviting students from all year groups in Primary and Secondary to return to the campus full time from Monday.

We have strong health and safety measures in place to minimise the risks to our community. However, if we do become aware of cases which may identify community members as close contacts, we may need to temporarily revert to online learning for some groups of students. Our aim is to maintain face to face learning as much as is both possible and practical, while minimising the risk of transmission to students, staff and parents.

We are now seeing cases with much milder symptoms such as headaches and sniffles which would still pose a risk of transmission to others. Please do not send your child to school if they have any possible symptoms. It remains important that each student carries out an antigen test each week before they come to school and that they stay at home if it is positive.
