Y9 and Y10 Residential Trip (6th-7th May, 2022)

It is with great delight that we are able to inform our students, parents and carers of a planned residential trip for our Year 9 and Year 10 students. This will be a special opportunity for our students to engage in Outdoor Learning activities, bond with peers and teachers, and experience a sense of independence that they may not have been able to since the start of the Covid pandemic.

The trip will start on **Friday 6th May**, with students departing our school campus at 12.00pm approximately. Students will then return to our campus and will be ready for collection by approximately 12.30pm on **Saturday 7th May** (please note that official timings will be shared in future communication).
