Dear Parents and Carers,

Parent Information Session: Year 6 to 7 Transition (Thursday 2nd June)

As you are aware, your child has been taking part in a number of different activities that have been designed to make their transition from Primary to Secondary school as smooth as possible. During Week 6 (30th May - 3rd June) the Year 6 students are being provided with a further range of opportunities that we hope will familiarise them with the Secondary school and help them feel more prepared and confident for this exciting journey. Firstly, they will join a current mentor group during a mentor session, allowing them to interact with current Year 7 and 8 students who will be in their Key Stage next year. This will also provide your child with an opportunity to observe how the day-to-day runnings of the Secondary school work, such as morning registration, student briefings and notices. They will participate in a range of different subject lessons that will provide the students with greater insight into the nature of secondary lessons, enabling them to get a feel for what is to come in the near future. These lessons will also allow our Year 6 students to meet some of the secondary teachers they will interact with next year.

We understand that a lot of questions may arise, not only in the students, but also from you as parents and carers. This is why we would like to **invite you all to a Parent Information Session on Thursday, June 2nd at 3.45pm**. The session will run for approximately 45 minutes and it will consist of myself (Mr Randall) and Mr Jayatilake presenting to you. We will review some of the important information communicated so far and also provide all parents with the opportunity to ask any questions they may have. Our current team of Key Stage 3 mentors will also be present to help clarify any information you do not understand. We want all of our students, and parents, to have clarity in what is a crucial stage of a child's learning journey.
