**Year 11, 12 and 13 Overnight Residential Trip to Park Village Resort, Budhanilkantha**  
**Please complete this [Google Form](#) to confirm your child's attendance by Friday 10th of June.**

On Monday 27th of June, we are planning to take our Year 11, 12 and 13 students on a one-night residential trip. The trip encompasses many activities that develop our 5Cs as well as working together, spending time away from home and being safe.

On the first day, we will leave school at 9.00am and be dropped off at Park Village Resort. Upon arrival, the students will be provided with their allocated rooms. A google form has been shared with students to allow them to select their roommates. Please remind you child to complete the form if they have not already done so. Whilst we will do our best to try to accommodate requests, their first or second choices cannot be guaranteed. Once settled, students will have a short introduction to, and be shown key areas of the resort. This will then be followed by lunch.

In the afternoon, there will be a range of activities that students will participate in, all of which are suitable for both indoors and outdoors, and are designed to support transition into KS5, and for all students to build positive relationships with each other and mentors. After dinner, there will be a team quiz and possibly a disco or another dancing 'event'.

On the second day, there will be a further range of activities. After which, students will pack and tidy their rooms, have a snack and return to school. We will aim to be back at school by 2.00pm on Tuesday 28th June.

Please note that Park Village Resort has a swimming pool, but does not provide a lifeguard. As no member of staff is a fully qualified lifeguard, the swimming pool will be out of bounds for all students.

We plan to leave school at **9:00am on Monday 27th June** and **return on Tuesday 28th June by approximately 3.00pm**. Students will be allowed to leave school upon their return from the trip so please ensure suitable arrangements have been made for their safe return home.

The cost of the trip will be covered by the school and will include transport, accommodation and food. Students can bring snacks if they wish, but please keep these to a minimum as all meals will be provided.

As we will leave on a Monday, students should log their COVID antigen test as normal on [this form](#) before coming to school. If students have not logged a negative test, they will be sent to the nurse to complete an antigen test and their attendance on the trip will be dependent on a negative result. **Students should arrive at school at the normal time i.e. by 8.20 am on Monday 27th June.**

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## Kit List for the KS5 Overnight Trip to Park Village Resort

### **Wearing on day one:**

Comfortable walking shoes or trainers  
Clothes suitable for travelling  
Suncream  
Hat  
Sunglasses (optional)

### **Overnight Bag (not too big, named) containing:**

Warm sweater/jumper  
Sandals / flip flops  
Pyjamas / sleeping clothes  
Wash bag including toothbrush/paste  
Change of underwear  
2 T-shirts  
1 pair of shorts  
1 pair of long trousers or tracksuit  
2 pairs of socks  
Plastic bag for dirty clothes

### **Small Day Bag (rucksack, named) containing:**

Waterproof coat/jacket  
Water bottle  
Sunblock cream  
Insect spray  
Sun hat  
Sunglasses  
Snacks

Please ensure that all items are named and students pack their own bags, with supervision if necessary.
