Blood Donation Appeal

With the rise of Dengue across the valleys, there are alarming shortages of blood products in blood banks risking patients' lives. In response to increasing the need for blood in our community, TBS is appealing to eligible donors to be part of a blood donation drive which will take place on 14th September, 2022 from 8:00 am - 1:00 pm in the school Hall. The event is supported by **Hamro LifeBank in coordination with Nepal Medicit Hospital** and is conducted with maintaining high quality medical standards.

The vision of this event is a 'vein-to-vein' program whereby blood donors will be notified once their blood has been used to save a life, which in turn will gratify their contribution towards the community.

To be eligible to donate blood, the donor must be healthy, at least 18 years old and weigh more than 45 kgs. The medical team will assess you prior to the blood donation e.g. checking blood pressure and hemoglobin level and taking your medical history etc. Please check this list of [criteria](#) before attending and make sure you have a good breakfast and are hydrated. You can encourage your family and friends to be a part of the drive whether or not you are not eligible to do so.
