Y10 English Literature - Picnic

As part of their study of GCSE English Literature Y10 students are studying a text called *Picnic At Hanging Rock* which features a number of topical themes such as colonialism, gender repression and class systems in society. To enrich their experience of studying this text we will be taking them on their own picnic as an immersive experience based on the text. This will take place on **Friday the 24th of March**.

Students will have the opportunity to read the text and explore the deeper meanings in a more tangible context. This will be a valuable opportunity for students to immerse themselves in a sensory environment and develop their perspective.

The students will have the opportunity to explore the environment around them at Central Zoo before having their picnic lunch and settling into a reading and writing workshop for a section of the afternoon. Students will need to bring their own packed lunch.

The trip will span the period 4 lesson of English Literature and lunch time with students returning in time for their final lesson of the day. We will travel on foot to the Zoo from TBS and return by the same route.
