- Swimming costume
- Goggles
- Towel
- Pool shoes (flip flops/chappal)
- Swimming cap recommended but not compulsory
- Change of clothes
- TBS PE kit if the session is cancelled for any reason normal PE will take place
- Sun cream and sun hat
- Jewellery should need to be taken off (preferably left at home for safe keeping). This includes watches and anything that could be a health and safety risk.

Behaviour

- Swimming is an essential skill to teach children, however there are potentially dangerous situations to occur due to the nature of swimming.
- The students do not run around the pool.
- The students do not enter the pool unless instructed to do so.
- The students do not dive, unless instructed.
- The students do not cause harm or put other students at risk.
- Failure to comply with these rules may result in the student being removed from the pool or from swimming all together.
- If a student is injured or cannot take part in swimming, they are required to attend to hear the instruction on this important life skill. They do not have alternative provision, they must attend the session even if they cannot physically take part.
