Every secondary mentor group has been randomly allocated a country with which a member of the TBS community has a connection. They will work with a primary class to produce a stall representing their assigned country. Students will research the country, prepare dishes, drinks and a cultural activity, such as a game, to showcase at their stall. During the festival, students will have the opportunity to learn, taste and experience cultural tidbits from around the globe whilst, very importantly, fundraising.

All money raised will go towards the TBS charity funds, which are used to support our community partners. Currently, we are working with 26 community partners which include government schools, children's homes and children's welfare organisations.
