Year 10 English Language Trip to Boudhanath **Wednesday 6th November, 2024**

As part of the English Language IGCSE coursework portfolio, students are required to produce a piece of descriptive writing. To help inspire students for this piece of work, we are arranging a trip to the Boudhanath Stupa in Kathmandu on **Wednesday 6th November 2024**. The trip will be an opportunity to gather ideas and to begin writing 'on location'. Students will travel by school bus to Boudhanath, departing from school at 08:45 am. They will return to school by 3:30 pm. As this is a curriculum-based school trip, the entrance fee to Boudha Stupa will be covered by the school, although students should bring some additional spending money for lunch, snacks and drinks at Utpala restaurant, where we have booked to undertake the draft-writing process from 12:00 pm onwards once students have toured the site.

Collection of students

Students who live near Boudhanath can be collected by a parent or carer from the main entrance to the stupa at 2.15 pm instead of travelling back to TBS. If you wish to collect your child, please notify me by email no later than Tuesday 5th November. If we do not hear from you by email by this time, your child will need to travel back to TBS. Similarly, if no one is present to collect them at 2.15 pm on the day of the trip, they will have to return to TBS; we will not be able to wait for them to be collected. Whoever is collecting your child will need to bring a photographic ID with them, ideally their TBS ID card. These arrangements are for the safety of your child.
