Year 8 Trip to Pokhara 20/01/25 - 24/01/25

We are delighted to inform you that a four-night residential trip has been planned for our Year 8 students to Pokhara, as an integral part of their curriculum. This exciting excursion will encompass a variety of activities centred around history, geography, sociology, business and psychology, providing our students with a thorough exploration of Pokhara's heritage and its surrounding geographical features. They will also have the opportunity to visit several museums and sites that are pivotal to Nepal's cultural heritage. Alongside this, they will develop presentation skills, fieldwork skills and teamwork skills.

The cost of the trip will be covered by the school. This includes transport by tourist coach, accommodation and food. However, your child should bring a packed lunch for the first day. Departure will be at 8.30 am on Monday 20th of January, returning by 3.25 pm, traffic dependent, on Friday 24th of January.
