Neurodiversity Celebration Concept:

Neurodiversity is about recognising those who think differently. During the week of March 17th to the 21st, TBS will be celebrating Neurodiversity Celebration Week. This is a worldwide initiative that challenges the stereotypes and misconceptions about neurological differences. The theme this year is "Celebrating Different Minds." Topics to be Discussed:

During the Parent Information Session, we will cover various aspects of neurodiversity, including:
